The ESTEEM project (European Safety Training and evaluation supporting European Mobility) tries to respond to the problem of health and safety of the workers which remains paramount across Europe

What are we doing?

ESTEEM will adopt a multi-national, multi-disciplinary and multi-focused approach for designing a methodology and full set of tools to develop and evaluate safety training programs. The goal of ESTEEM is to maximise the quality and efficacy of safety training programmes provided in EU.

- **Enhance access to training and qualifications for all** by shaping its training activities to the needs and competencies of low-skill and migrant workers in the construction industry.
- **Promote Social Inclusion** by applying design project methodologies which include stakeholders' needs from the very beginning.

- Aid the mobility of workers within the EU by developing a Safety Training Certificate System for trainers and trainees which is transparent and which provides trainees with a certification of skills recognised across the EU.

Why?

- ➤ Often outcomes of safety training are **not assessed**, neither is its effectiveness.
- ➤ Theoretical knowledge acquired during safety training programmes is often not "transferred" to actual on-the-job workers' behaviours.
- The delivery of effective safety training should be addressed to **all workers equally** especially low-skilled & migrant workers, which are mostly employed in the construction sector.
