Third Newsletter - ESTEEM Project

The ESTEEM project (European Safety Training and Evaluation supporting European Mobility) tries to respond to the problem of health and safety of workers in the construction industry, which remains paramount across Europe

What happened in these months?

The last months were very intense as many activities have been conducted also during the COVID pandemic. Here are the main facts:

- The training has been implemented in Italy and Spain. In total, more 100 workers completed the training and were awarded the training certificate.
- We are conducting in-depth analyses able to give more information about the effectiveness of the training: participants answered a questionnaire before the training, after the training, 3 months after the training and 6 months after the training in order to measure training transfer and related processes. The full results of this evaluation will be available soon!
- We have put forward new scientific knowledge on safety training for migrant workers: we published a systematic literature review ([link](#)) and a special issue on safety among migrant workers in the journal Safety Science will be published soon.
